Hepworth Farms is a small, diversified, ecologically managed farm located on the banks of the Hudson River. Our farm has been in our family for seven generations. Our last 25 years of work have been dedicated to organic and ecologically sustainable fruit and vegetable farming.

For your CSA we will provide ecologically sustainable fruit at the wholesale price. Our produce is grown utilizing the Whole Farm Alive Systems Approach with IPM (Integrated Pest Management).

The fruit will be picked fresh for you and delivered on Tuesdays to your pick-up site (to be announced) in Cobble Hill, Brooklyn. The 2007 fruit season for the Cobble Hill CSA will last 25 weeks, from June 26, 2007 through December 11, 2007. During this season, we will be harvesting:

- Cherries and strawberries in July
- Peaches, plums, nectarines and melons in July, August and September
- Apples and pears from August through November

Pick-up occurs on Tuesdays, from 4:00 to 8:00 P.M. at a pick-up site to be announced. We cannot refund your money for pick-ups that you miss. Friends may pick up in your place.
